During the Field Inspection, all noted conditions that might result in harm to people, loss of property, damage to equipment or the environment will be assigned a Hazard Classification. The intent is to determine the loss potential and the priority for corrective action. Southern Heat Exchanger Services will use the hazard classification A,B,C, which will denote the following:

- Class A Hazard: A condition or practice likely to cause permanent disability, loss of life, or body part and/or extensive loss of structure, equipment or material, or a reportable environmental incident. The corrective action will be initiated immediately.
  
- Class B hazard: A condition or practice likely to cause a serious injury or illness, resulting in temporary disability or property/environmental damage that is disruptive but, not extensive. The corrective action will be initiated within three (3) working days.
  
- Class C Hazard: A condition or practice likely to cause minor, non-disability or illness or non-disruptive property/environmental damage. The corrective action will be initiated within two (2) weeks.

This information will be included on the inspection form checklist.
